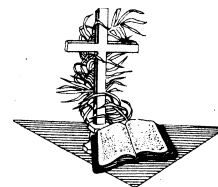

## From The Pulpit

As individuals and communities, we are sometimes like the Corinthians. We use the gifts we have received from God to divide, rather than unite. We prize some gifts over others, imagining that the more “impressive” gifts (like speaking in tongues) provide better evidence of the Spirit’s presence than more “ordinary” gifts (like teaching or healing). By our personal and corporate behaviour, we often obscure the gospel message and make its reception difficult or impossible. Today’s readings, then, come as both a sober reminder and as a threat relief! We have been created ad re-created by the breath of God. Filled with the Spirit of new life, the whole Church continues the work Jesus began, engaging in a new kind of speaking that powerfully proclaims the deeds of God so all can understand and believe. We can work for unity by putting an end to competition, strife and divisions in our communities, and valuing each one’s God-given gifts. We can exercise the same power over sin that Jesus did, especially by the authentic and inviting witness of lives lived according to the truth about God, revealed in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. All this may be accomplished when we are thankful for our dependence on God, rejoice that Jesus is Lord, and offer ourselves willingly to help renew the face of the earth.

## FRATERNAL BENEFITS ADVISOR REPORT



### SOMETIMES IT IS EASY TO OVERLOOK THE SIMPLEST OF THINGS

Check the beneficiaries on your life insurance policies. If your policy was applied for and issued several years ago, it could very well be that the beneficiary originally designated to receive the proceeds from that policy needs to be updated. If you bought the policy when you were single, for example, you may have named your parents as beneficiaries. If you have since been married, that could be updated to reflect your spouse, and even your children.

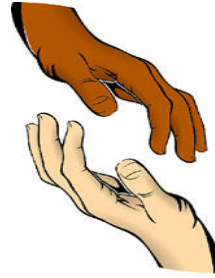

### CORPUS CHRISTI (BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST)



**The Solemnity of Corpus Christi**



commemorates the institution of the Holy Eucharist, paralleling Maundy Thursday (Holy Thursday) commemorating Our Lord's institution of the Eucharist. Corpus Christ was introduced in the late 13th century to encourage the faithful give special honor to the institution of the Holy Eucharist to the Blessed Sacrament. Corpus Christi became a mandatory feast in the Roman Church in 1312. But nearly a century earlier, Saint Juliana of Mont Cornillon, promoted a feast to honor the Blessed Sacrament. From early age Juliana, who became an Augustinian nun in Liège, France, in 1206, had a great veneration for the Blessed Sacrament, and longed for a special feast in its honor. She had a vision of the Church under the appearance of the full moon having one dark spot, which signified the absence of such a solemnity. She made known her ideas to the Bishop of Liège, Robert de Thorete, to the Dominican Hugh who later became cardinal legate in the Netherlands, and to Jacques Panaléon, at the time Archdeacon of Liège and who later became Pope Urban IV. Bishop Robert de Thorete ordered that the feast be celebrated in his diocese.
